

apathy


Jaundice

and others)

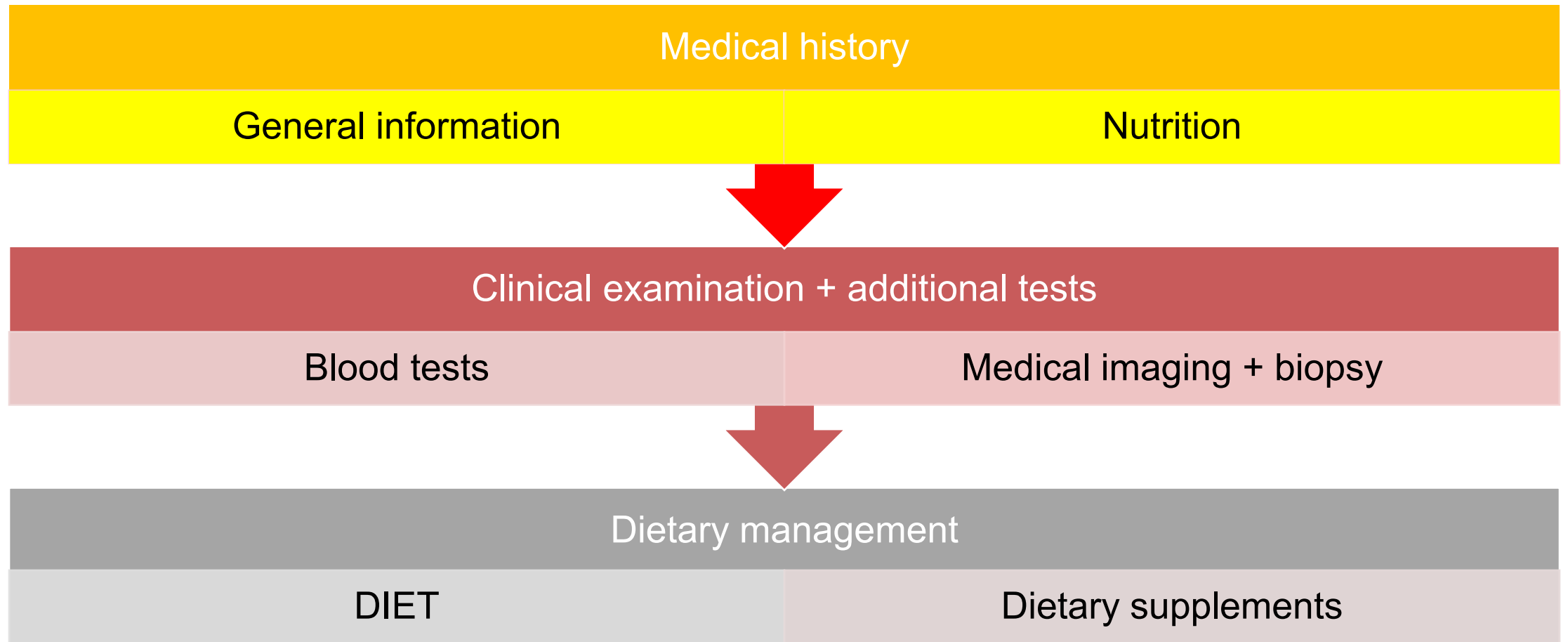


Overweight/obesity/other diseases

Liver diseases - diagnosis and dietary management





Dietary management

Simple, natural ingredients:

- MONOPROTEIN: 46% chicken
- Rice (3%)
- Brewing yeast (1%)
- Minerals (1%)
- Oils and fats (0.5% salmon oil)

Liver diseases - dietary management



46% chicken - a mono-protein diet based on the most digestible protein



Moderate protein content of 8% with 5.7% fat - liver cell regeneration without overloading the liver



Omega-6 (0.8%) and Omega-3 (0.5%) fatty acids - regeneration of cell membranes, anti-inflammatory effect



Limited copper content (2mg/kg) - protection against excessive accumulation of copper in the liver of sick cats
