Lower urinary tract diseases in cats



50% Feline urinary
cystitis (FIC)



Kidney stones
Struvites,
oxalates,
other



Cancer
Anatomical defects
Infectious diseases

Risk factors for stones: 1. struvite, 2. oxalate

1. Females; <7 years old
2. Males; >7 years old



1. Long and short-haired domestic cats
2. Tokyo, Burmese, Himalayan, Devon-rex, Persian, Siamese



1. and 2. overweight or obese, sterilised cats





Urinary Diet



Balanced diet based on easily digestible animal proteins: 34% turkey, 34% beef



Controlled ion levels: Ca (0.23%); P (0.21%); Na (0.22%); Mg (0.05%); Cl (0.27%); S (0.24%)



Cranberry (2%): reduces the adhesion of pathogens to the urinary tract mucosa



DL-methionine (4000mg/kg): lowers urinary pH; helps protect the urinary tract from pathogens



A grain-free, gluten-free diet

Recommended length of diet therapy

- Targeted pharmacotherapy
- Introduction of the **Urinary** diet – initially for 5 to 12 weeks
- In case of infectious diseases - the supplement **UrinoVet Cat** is additionally recommended
- In the case of FIC - a multidirectional approach is recommended to minimise the animal's stress factors and to introduce the **KalmVet** supplement

Control of the cat's health

- After a positive check-up, it is recommended to introduce moist foods such as **RAW PALEO** lines into your cat's diet
- and to make regular check-ups, initially every 1-3 months, then every 6 months
- Periodic stimulation of immunity - **VetoMune**
