

# URINARY DOG

PROTECTION OF THE  
**LOWER URINARY TRACT**  
IN DOGS



The diet supports the **dissolution of struvite stones** and **reduces their recurrence**.



**Low protein level** - limits the synthesis of metabolites necessary for the formation of crystals and stones.



**Low phosphorus level/low magnesium content** - limits the availability of these ions for the formation of crystals and stones,



**Calcium sulfate** - has urine-acidifying properties, thereby creating unfavourable conditions for the formation of struvites.



**Mountain cranberry** - reduces the adhesion of microorganisms to the urinary tract epithelium, decreasing the risk of secondary bacterial infections.
